Through the Years

 - ★ Started with 200 shoeboxes filled with school supplies and 103 volunteers

- ★ Collected 3,450 shoeboxes and was supported by 363 devoted volunteers



Create your D-I-Y shoeboxes or dream kits by getting an old shoebox and wrapping the lid and box separately with colorful recycled paper or gift wrappers. Make sure the box you're using is sturdy and in good condition.



Fill-in shoeboxes with the **school supplies** needed.

- One (1) plastic envelope with handle
- One (1) pack of A4 bond paper (50s)
- two (2) notebooks,
- one (1) pad paper
- two (2) pens
- two (2) pencils
- one (1) eraser
- one (1) box of crayons


